Jekka's Herb Farm is a multi-award winning organic herb nursery which grows **over 600 varieties of culinary, medicinal, aromatic and decorative herbs**, available to order online.

The farm is usually closed to the public, but four times each year, their gates are flung wide open and everyone is warmly welcomed to browse and buy amongst the herbs, and chat to Jekka McVicar and her team of herb experts.

“Medicinal Herbs in the Home” is a 45 minute lecture with ‘Queen of Herbs’ Jekka McVicar, and offers a friendly and fascinating insight into herbal first aid for everyday use.

The lecture runs each afternoon on 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> March, costs £7.50 per head and can be booked online now.



Jekka's Herb Farm Open Days are a treat for gardeners, cooks, herb novices and experts alike. Organically grown herbs and seeds are available to browse and buy, and Jekka is on hand to sign her books. Meander amongst the herbs, breathe in the aroma and hand-pick your herb garden.
